



OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD



Now would be a good time to keep in mind those items needed for the shoeboxes. Items may be packed throughout the year. You can also donate the price of shipping the shoeboxes, \$7, during the year. It is really fun to find things the children will love to have!

Right now might be a good time to buy hygiene products. Toothpaste can no longer be included in the shoeboxes. Items to include are toothbrushes, bar soap, combs, brushes, washcloths and small towels.

Remember to use a regular size shoebox. You can get the plastic ones at Dollar Tree and Wal-Mart. The plastic boxes are sturdier and will hold up better that the cardboard ones. Some of the plastic boxes have a lid that sets on top of the box and other lids have handles and clamps to hold the top on. Either one is fine.

CINNAMON ROLL FRENCH TOAST CASSEROLE

INGREDIENTS

Casserole

- 2 (17.5 oz.) cans refrigerated cinnamon rolls, icing reserved
- 2 Tbsp. melted butter
- 4 eggs
- S! c. milk
- 1 Tbsp. cinnamon
- 1 tsp. vanilla

Icing

- ½ c. powdered sugar
- 2 containers reserved icing
- 2 Tbsp. cream cheese, softened
- 1 Tbsp. milk
- (For extra icing, combine ¾ c. powdered sugar + 3 oz. cream cheese (softened) + 1½ Tbsp. milk)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Remove cinnamon rolls from packages and cut each roll into sixths.
- 3. Drizzle melted butter in 9x13 inch pan.
- 4. Spread cinnamon roll pieces evenly in pan.
- 5. In a separate bowl, combine eggs, milk, cinnamon, and vanilla. Whisk until combined.
- 6. Pour egg mixture over cinnamon rolls.
- 7. Bake at 350 degrees for 30-35 minutes or until top of casserole is golden brown and center is set.
- 8. Prepare icing by combining reserved cinnamon roll icing with ½ c. powdered sugar, 2 Tbsp. softened cream cheese, and 1 Tbsp. milk. Whisk until smooth.
- 9. Pour icing evenly over casserole.








Happy Father's Day June 18, 2017
