Salem Lutheran Church Council Minutes Meeting November 14th, 2017

Council Members in Attendance:

Pastor Dan, Rob Barjenbruch, Clint Myers, Dottie Hahn, and Lindy Cain **Devotional**- "Understanding" shared by Pastor Dan **Prayer**

Approval of Agenda – Pastor Dan moved, Clint seconded, motion carried.

Approval of Minutes from previous meeting – Pastor Dan moved, Clint seconded, motion carried.

*New Business: Retha Hahn was present at our meeting and gave council an overview of what the Salem Lutheran Financial Secretary role in our church and described the difference between this role and the role of the council treasurer position. The financial secretary is not allowed to serve on council nor are they allowed to count offerings. Retha has diligently held this position for several years and asked to resign at this council meeting, to be effective when the position has been filled. The congregational council appoints the Financial Secretary. After resigning, she recommended Kristel Knipling as a good choice to take her place. Since Kristel is presently the treasurer for council, the Nominating Committee would need to fill the position for the remaining year of her term.

Reports:

Treasurer – Written report was reviewed in Kristel's absence **Pastor** – Stewardship Brunch rescheduled for December 3rd **Proclaim** – Nothing this meeting

Nurture – Dottie reported that the Sunday School teachers had decided not to do a Christmas program this year. Also, due to lack of Sunday school attendance they would like to combine the Pre-K and moved. Also, a family integrated Sunday school was suggested, and Pastor Dan volunteered to look into what options are available.

Response – Nothing this meeting

Property – Lindy asked about the playground progress and Clint said that it would take time, volunteers, and a ton of work to prepare the current playground area to put in the new (already purchased) playground set. Jennifer recommended that we move the playground to the space inside of the windbreak behind the Fellowship Hall.

All present thought that this was an excellent idea and decided to give all of the church members that attended the Stewardship Brunch the opportunity to discuss the options.

Old Business – Need to notify nominating committee that they need to meet soon. Also, need to put a cleaning contract together.

New Business -

1) Roof Estimate is \$23,000. The cash received for all the damage is \$32,000. The money required to complete the roofing of the Fellowship Hall and the Education Building is in hand and is scheduled. The bid for the remaining repairs will be received soon and the council will keep the congregation informed as we make progress. A special congregational meeting with be called if needed to expend extra funds.

Clint also suggested that the church look at the infrastructure of the plumbing. It was also noted that the rain gutters on the office building are rusted all the way through.

- 2) Pastor Dan has been talking to other churches and they are discussing a community vacation bible school for next summer.
- 3) Advent offering will be given to Bloomington School Teachers and staff as a loving gift of support. Pastor Dan moved, Clint seconded, motion carried.

2017 Advent Offering

The Salem lutheran Church Congregational Council voted to designate our 2017 Advent Offerings to purchase gift cards for the teachers and staff of Bloomington ISD. Advent Offerings include undesignated offerings from Wednesday evening and offerings marked "Advent" on Sunday mornings. The request came from Machaela Zellmer who works with some visually impaired students on their campuses. Machaela shared the following:

"Teaching is a challenging and vastly rewarding profession.

Teaching in an open building with 6 other classes happening at the same time with limited material resources makes it exponentially more challenging. Each campus in Bloomington ISD suffered severe damage to at least one building. Very few teachers in the district have been able to teach in the classrooms they had prepared for their students before the storm.

In spite of this, the staff and teachers of Bloomington ISD have risen to the challenge. They have loved and nurtured their students and have helped them navigate life post-Harvey."

As a congregation, we have the opportunity to "share the love of Christ" with them. The congregational council has designated the Advent offering to go towards the purchase of gift cards for each of the 145 teachers and staff members at Bloomington ISD. Included with the gift card will be a note of encouragement cheering them on. Along with your prayers, please consider giving, so we can place in their hands a tangible reminder of Christ's love and our encouragement.


