FROM THE PASTOR'S COMPUTER

Way too many jokes include the phrase: "I've got good news and I've got bad news. Which do you want first?" The good/bad determination is up to the hearer, but in my article last month I shared my decision to retire at the end of this year. At the annual congregational meeting I shared some data about our attendance and our giving during 2017 that indicates that our vitality and the ability for this congregation to afford a full-time pastor now and in the future needs to be looked at carefully sooner rather than later.

As I sat down to write this article I procrastinated by checking my email. My attention was grabbed by the subject line: "Fly through the crash." Here is what it said:

The night before I was about to launch the biggest project of my life, I got some of the best leadership advice ever from Sally Ahrens, my partner in ministry. She looked me in the eye and said with all seriousness:

"No matter what happens, fly through the crash."

At this point in our preparation, I knew she wasn't kidding, but I also had no idea what she was talking about, so I just gave her the "huh?" look.

"Fly through the crash. You just might land the plane," was her response. This was only a few weeks after the plane had landed in the Hudson River. I got it.

I am sharing this with you today because I have come to realize that the language of "being in survival- mode" that people use regarding their congregation does not fit at all. Every story I know about survival-mode has a high level of "fighting for life" that includes a willingness to fly through the crash.

Survival behavior is hopeful because it brings an instinct for living that overcomes a willingness to die.

I believe that this email was a tap on the shoulder from God. In spite of the "facts;" we are still called to be disciples and God is still ready to walk with us as we do ministry in this community. I believe that now is the time to figure out how we might be able to "Fly through the crash" and see where we land.

Part of flying through the crash will obviously be for more of us to step up and become a part of the ministry that is happening. I am quite pleased to share that we were down to four assisting ministers until the meeting that I called for those interested in that role in worship. I now have nine people on that list and I say, "Thank You!!!" to each of them.

Please let our leaders know that you would like to be a part of whatever specific pieces you are interested in. Together we can and will be strong. There is no telling where we will land.
