There will be a card with the items needed for that month available the first Sunday of each month. Some information as to why we are choosing the items that you see listed. Food Stamps or SNAP does not cover cleaning supplies, paper products, and hygiene products for women or men. Neither can vitamins, supplements, or medicine be purchased with Food Stamps. Our goal is to help folks through a difficult time. I have met with eight other pastors, folks from The Harbor, United Way, The Food Pantry and the police. We are working to not duplicate services and to support each other as we help the community. We may not be able to solve all the problems, but we can still make a difference
