Blessing of the Backpacks for school kids will be August 7<sup>th</sup>. Pancakes breakfast will be held also on August 7<sup>th</sup> after service. It is necessary to notify the congregation of a special called congregational meeting on July 31<sup>st</sup>. There is a current bid for new entry doors for the Sanctuary, new exterior door at the Sacristy, and a new exterior door in the Education Building, all from Castle Construction. \$5000 has already been donated to replacing these doors, \$13,000 more is needed. Permission is needed from the congregation to use Parsonage Funds to confirm and the cost of the bid, and then replace the funds with donations when we receive them. A letter will go out to the congregation to explain.


