

Valentine's Day Trash Recipe

Ingredients:

24 oz. vanilla flavored candy coating (almond bark) 6 cups Kellogg's Crispix cereal 3 cups round shaped pretzels 16 oz. M&M'S Peanut Chocolate Candies in Valentine's Colors or plain M&M's

Directions:

In a medium microwave safe bowl, melt chocolate in the microwave for 2-4 minutes at 30 SECOND intervals until chocolate is melted; set aside.
